
+ Interest-based collective labour disputes

Labour disputes are disputes concerning the rights, obligations or interests that arise among the parties in the process of establishing, implementing or terminating labour relations, disputes among workers' representative organisations, or disputes arising from relations that are directly related to labour relations.

## Rights-based collective labour disputes

Rights-based collective labour disputes are disputes between one or more workers' representative organisations and an employer or one or more employers' organisations that arise in the following cases:

Differences in the understanding and implementation of the terms and conditions in collective bargaining agreements, internal work regulations or other lawful regulations and agreements. В

Differences in the understanding and implementation of labour law.



When employers are alleged to:
-discriminate against workers or
leaders of a workers'
representative organization
because of their efforts to
establish, join or undertake the
workers' representative
organization activities;
-intervene in or manipulate a
workers' representative
organization;
-fail to negotiate in good faith.

When either party rejects collective bargaining or does not undertake bargaining within the time stipulated by the law.




